OSHA 10 Hour

General Industry Outreach Training Program

This course is ideal for supervisors with safety and health responsibilities, and for employee safety and health awareness. Students will be introduced to OSHA policies, procedures and standards as well as general industry safety and health principles covered in OSHA Act Part 1910. Special emphasis will be placed on areas most hazardous using OSHA standards as a guide. Participants who successfully complete the course will receive a card from OSHA certifying completion of the course. Ten classroom hours: \$170.

OSHA 30 Hour

General Industry Outreach Training Program

The thirty hour general industry outreach training course provides complete information on OSHA compliance issues. OSHA recommends the 30 Hour general industry outreach training programs as an orientation to occupational safety and health for workers covered by OSHA 29 CFR 1910. General industry workers must receive additional training, when required by OSHA standards, on specific hazards of the job. Thirty classroom hours: \$550.
